What we collect

We may collect the following information:

- Name
- Contact information including email address
- Demographic information such as home address
- Information on the building enquiry including attachments if supplied by yourself
- Information on your work experience if supplied by yourself via our careers page

What we do with the information we gather

We require this information to understand your needs and provide you with a better service, and in particular for the following reasons:

- If an enquiry becomes an active quotation and/or a contract of work with us we will hold your details for 7 years, these details will be held electronically and within a paper job folder.
- Website usage information is collected using cookies.
- From time to time, we may also use your information to contact you for market research purposes. We may contact you by email, phone, fax or mail. We may use the information to customise the website according to your interests.
- Upright Construction will only pass on contact details to contractors relating to building work with your prior consent.

Security

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.

How we use cookies

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive. Once you agree, the file is added and the cookie helps analyse web traffic or lets you know

when you visit a particular site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. The web application can tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences.

We use traffic log cookies to identify which pages are being used. This helps us analyse data about web page traffic and improve our website in order to tailor it to customer needs. We only use this information for statistical analysis purposes.
